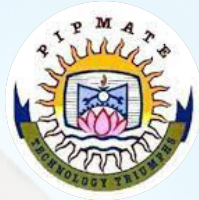

- Ministry of Human Resource Development provided assistance through “World Bank under Technical Education-II Project” and “Sub-Mission on Polytechnics under Coordinated Action for Skill Development”.
- Upgraded to Women’s Engineering College.
- Administered by Directorate of Higher and Technical Education through Pondicherry Institute of Post Matric Technical Education (PIPMATE) Society
- Affiliated to Puducherry Technological University.
- B.Tech degree courses introduced from academic year 2022-23 with approval from AICTE, New Delhi.
- Diploma in Modern Office Practice upgraded to Bachelor of Commerce in affiliation with Pondicherry University from academic year 2022-23.
- Our Institution has been functioning as IIT Bombay Remote Centre (RC-ID 1400) since February 2018, in the existing e-Classroom established under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme” Up-gradation of existing Polytechnic Colleges”, MHRD, GoI.
- The e-classroom is air-conditioned and has modern equipment, including 33 computer systems, a laptop, LCD projector, television, video camera, and more. The center is registered with Amrita Virtual Interactive e-Learning World for online courses for students and faculty.

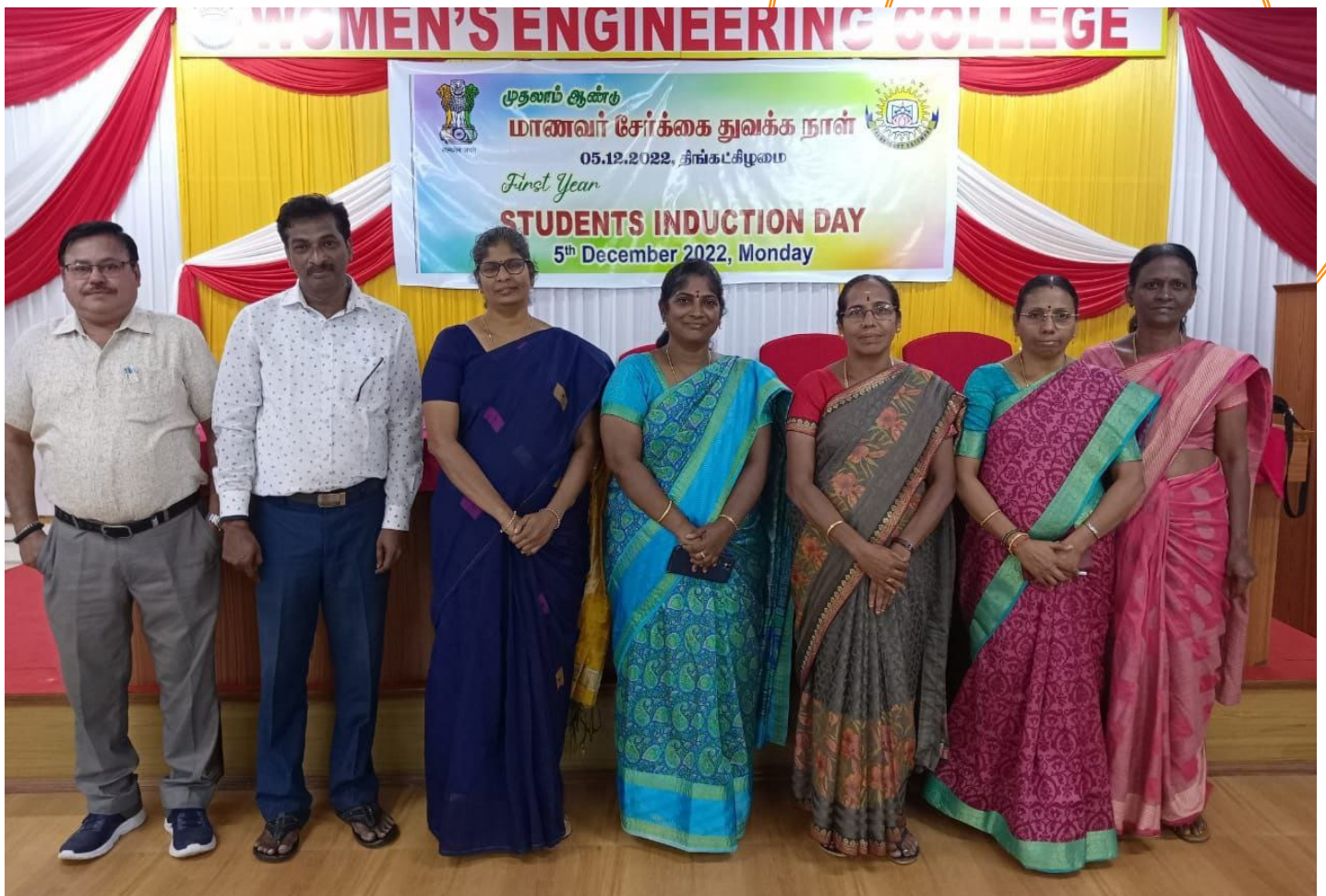

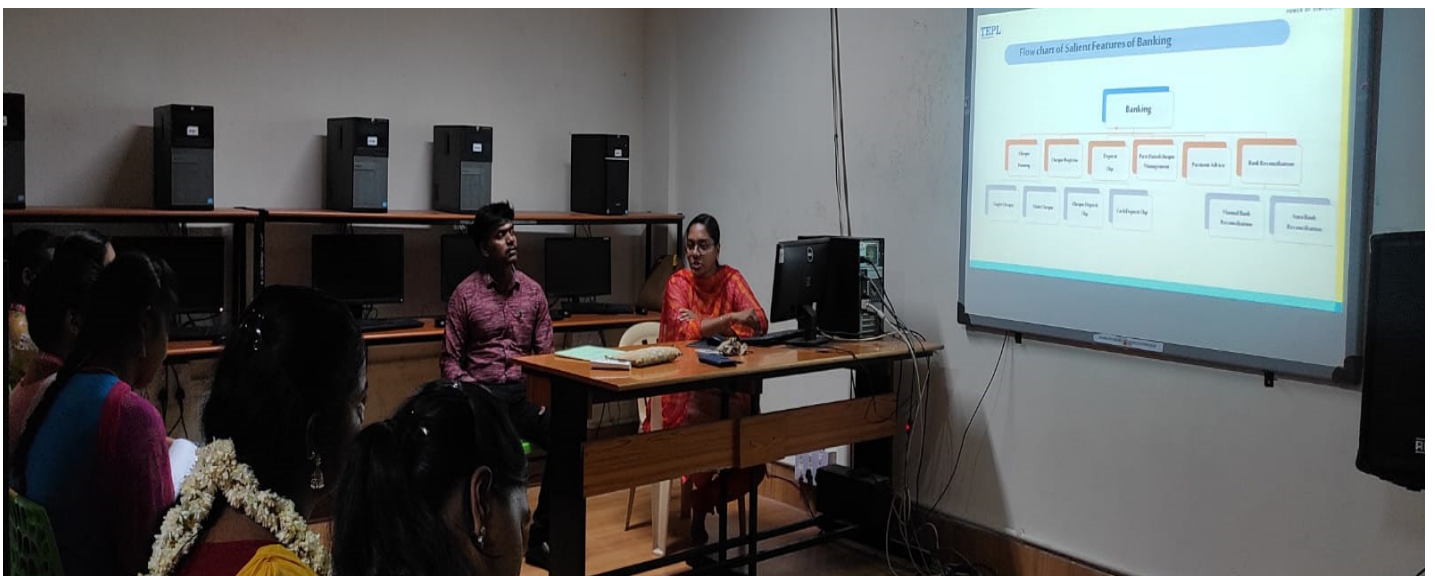
Tally Prime Training Programme
